		2. Students also expressed their acceptance on lab facilities, list of experiments, departmental internal evaluation practices and content beyond syllabus. (8, 9, 10).	Satisfactory outcome
		3. Some of the students were not satisfied with communication and professional skills. There should be departmental roadmap for skill development (Question no 11, 13 and 14).	There is a strong requirement of organizing career-oriented activities.
		4. Under the 'any other suggestions' section, some of student suggested in remark column expressed that they are finding difficulty in clearing reappear subjects.	Need to work on motivating weak students so that they can improve their results.
2	Teacher	1. As an exception to the satisfaction expressed by teachers on most of the issues, few of teachers have expressed disagreement on sufficient numbers of prescribed books are available in the library and optional subjects in the syllabus (Q No. 8 and 9).	Need to add new text and reference books in the library. Some of the optional elective subjects to be introduced in next syllabus revision.

3	Alumni	1. Alumni have shown concern over level of final year projects under question no. 12.	More focus on industrial based projects also need to improve laboratory practices so that student can learn practical hands-on training.
		2. Under the suggestions they have indicated that the training programmes may be organized which will help to improve the placement opportunities.	Need to organize more training and industrial visits.
