The **Management** of PIET inspired young aspirants and talked about placements and **start-ups through Project Based Learning technique (PBL)**.

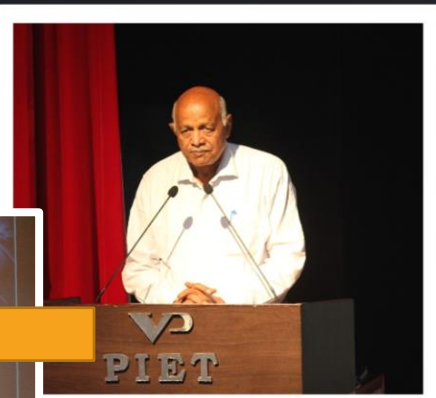

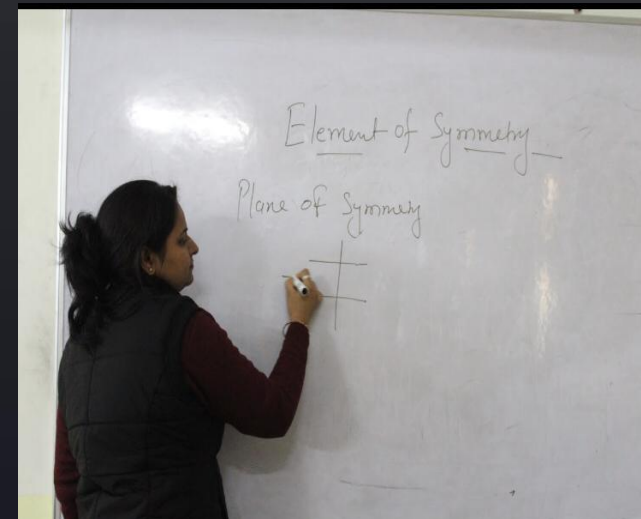


BRIDGE CLASSES

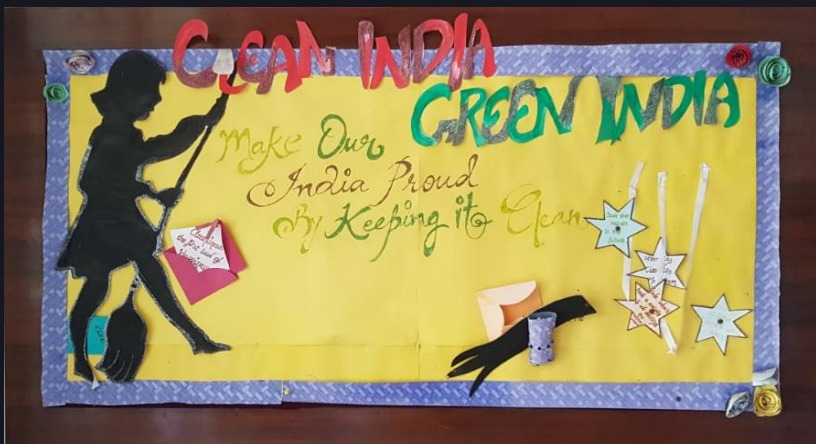
