Introduction

The National Pharmacovigilance Week is observed every year across India with the objective of spreading awareness about the safe and rational use of medicines. It is an initiative of the Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI) under the Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

The Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI) was launched on 23rd July 2010 by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, with the Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC), Ghaziabad as the National Coordinating Centre.

The National Pharmacovigilance Week itself was started later by IPC under PvPI to create mass awareness about drug safety and the importance of reporting adverse drug reactions. The first Pharmacovigilance Week was observed in 2019, and since then, it has been celebrated every year across the country with a specific theme.

General Rules


- Participation is open to all students of the Pharmacy Department.

- Judging Criteria (for all categories): Creativity (30%), Relevance (20%), Clarity (20%), Presentation (20%), Response/Impact (10%).


Digital Awareness Campaign (E-pamphlet/Reel)


