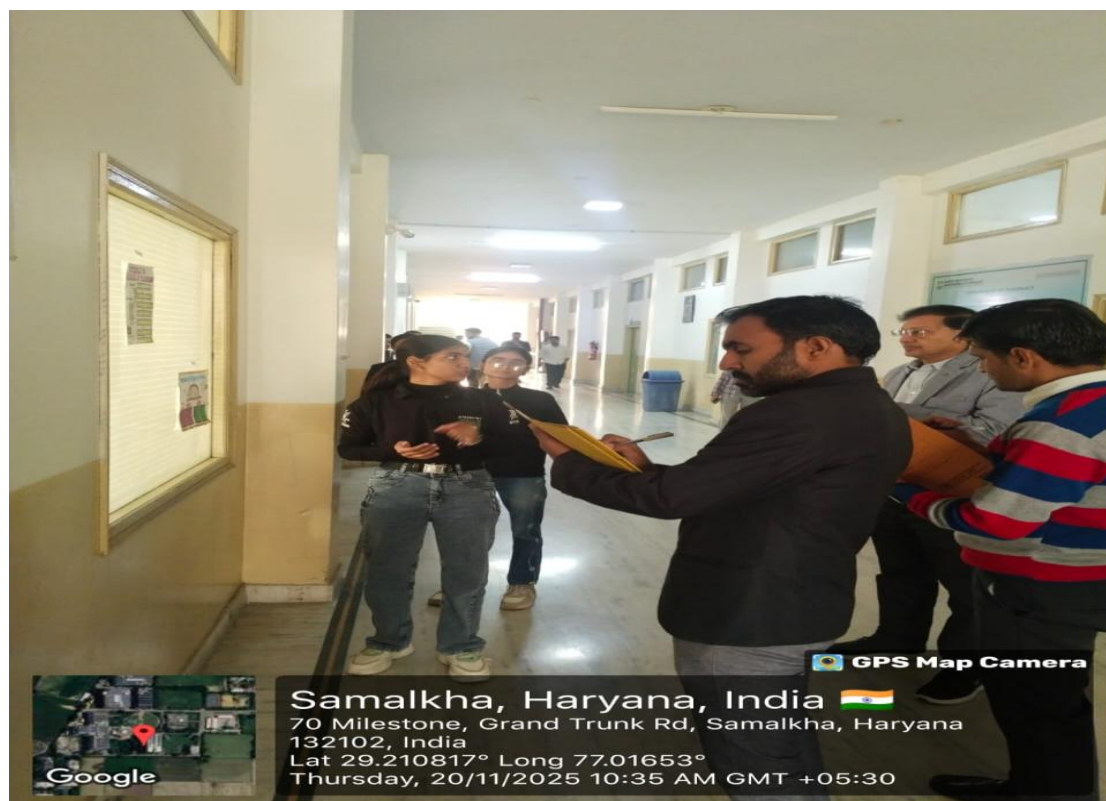

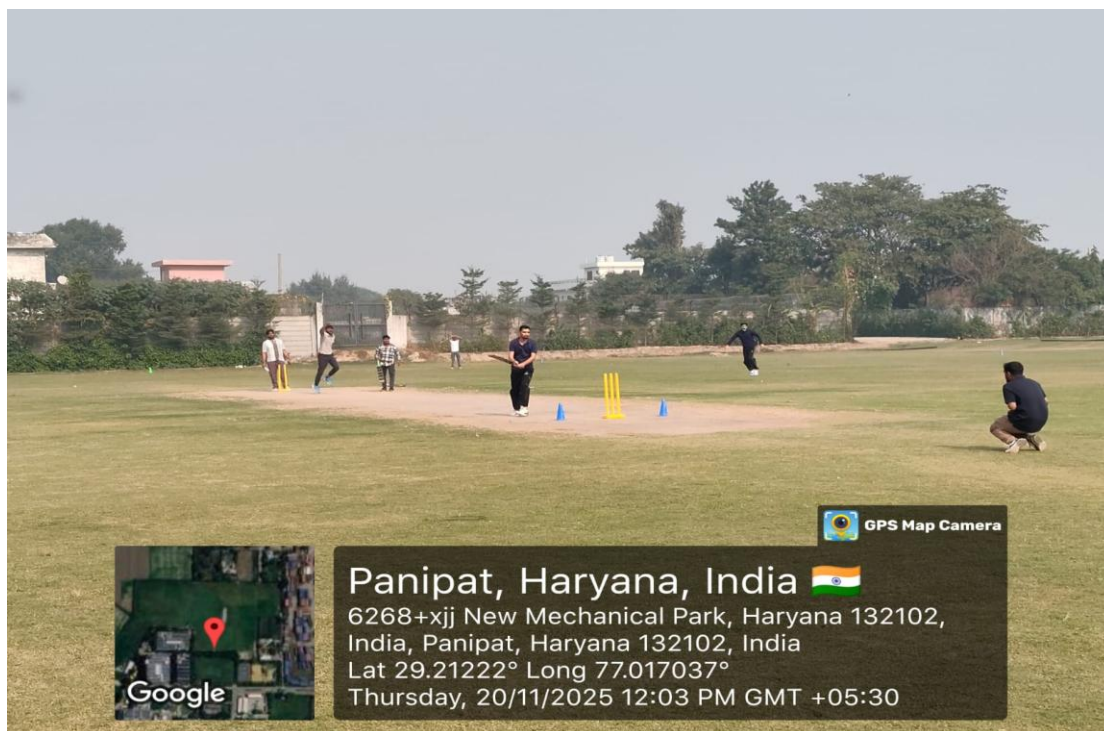

On **21st** November **2025**, General Health check-up camp including various activities such as, Eye check-up camp as part of Ophthalmology screening, Orthology screening and Physiotherapy services were conducted. Students showed great enthusiasm to be a part of the health checkup team and successfully accomplished their goals. The general health checkup camp covered various parameters like BP monitoring, blood glucose level monitoring, body temperature, height, weight, BMI measurements, and counseling on common problems. The aim of organizing the health camp was to sensitize the students and make them more confident towards such activities.

Students witnessed the preliminary checkups of 83 staff members of PIET including bus drivers, conductors, sweepers, administrative staff, technicians, and teaching faculty. 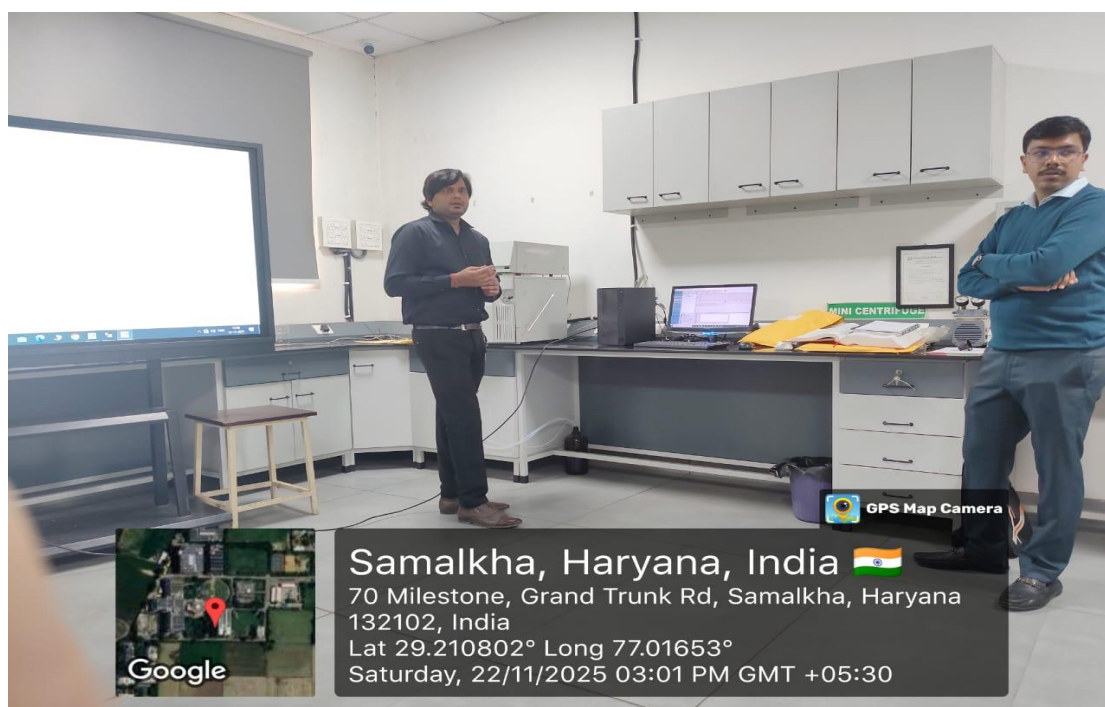
